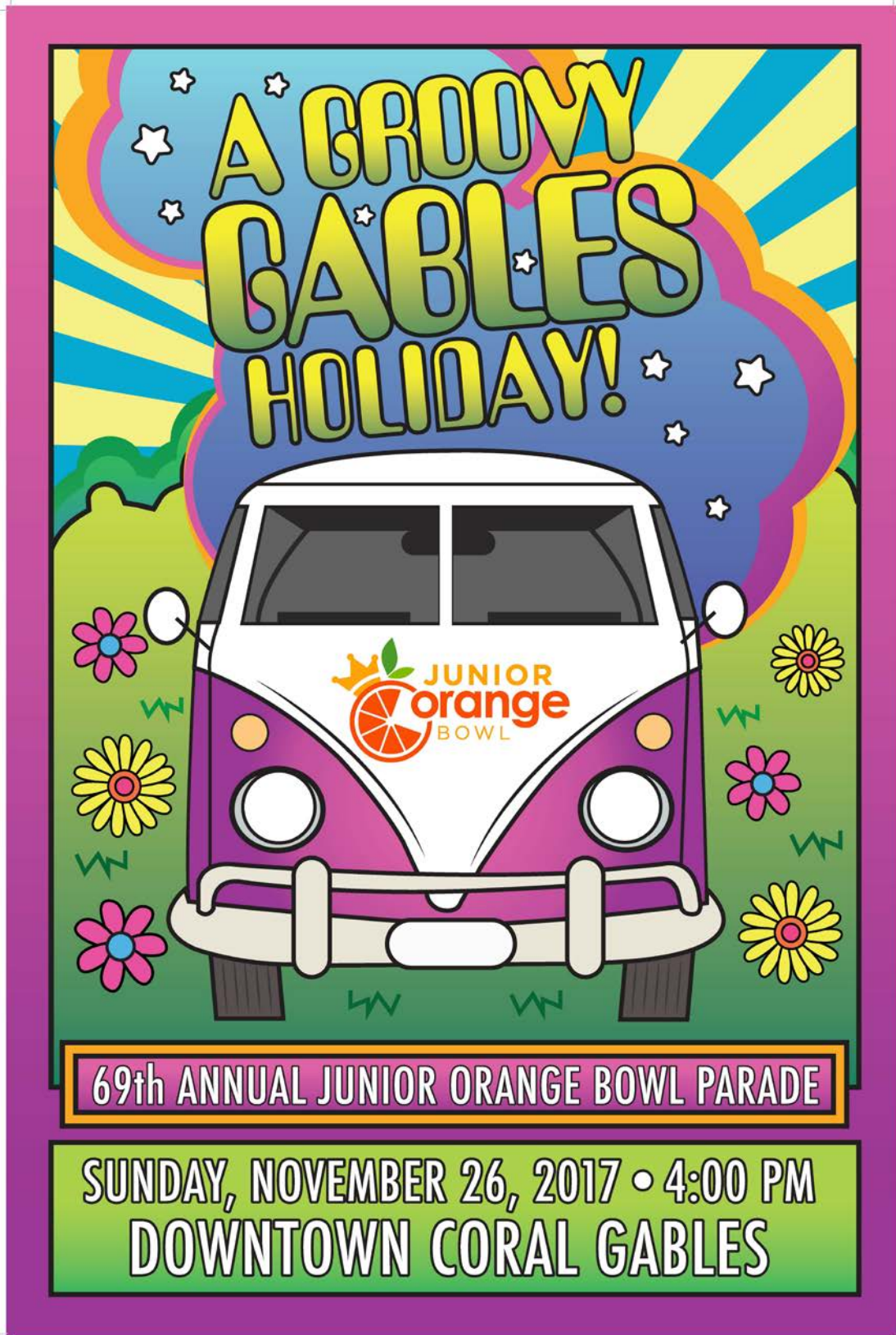

- Total march time is approximately 40 minutes, no more than an hour
- This Parade will be televised!

Please fill out the application completely. Return it by mail, or scan and email it to us, no later than **Friday, September 29, 2017**. A committee will review all the applications and make selections on who will be invited to participate.

PLEASE NOTE: This is an *invitational event*. You must be selected by the Junior Orange Bowl Committee to participate in the parade.

Please do not show up to march in the parade if you have not received prior notification that your unit was selected to be in parade.

IN CONSIDERATION of the Junior Orange Bowl Committee, Inc. for accepting this entry, we the Participant(s), Parent(s) and/or Guardian(s), contestants, jointly, severally, and intending to legally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, do hereby waive, release and discharge the Junior Orange Bowl Committee, Inc., the City of Coral Gables, Miami-Dade County, the owners and managers of any public and/or private facility used for the Junior Orange Bowl Parade, all Junior Orange Bowl festival sponsors, all Junior Orange Bowl Members, Staff and Volunteers, all Supervising or coordinating organizations and all of the above members, agents, employees, representatives, successors and assigns from any and all liability and/or claims for illness, injuries, death, disfigurement and loss of property that may arise directly or indirectly as a result of participating in the Junior Orange Bowl Parade, or of his/her travel to and from event venues.

PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

You are responsible for making sure everyone in your unit is knowledgeable of the parade rules. Please read through carefully!

1. Make sure there is one release form filled out for each person who will be participating in the parade.
2. All participants and chaperones walking with the unit are encouraged to be costumed with the theme of the parade or the unit.
3. All participants must provide their own costumes.
4. The contact person should be with the unit at all times during staging and the parade.
5. Parents or chaperones standing in between the grandstands or in front of the grandstands without a ticket will be escorted away from the grandstand area. **If you want to see the pre-parade show, you must be seated in the grandstands.**
6. Units that stop during the parade without permission to do so will not be invited back.
7. No objects may be thrown into the crowd. If any object is thrown, insurance coverage is null and void.
8. No fire batons or pyrotechnic equipment.
9. Children must be at least five years old to participate in the parade.
10. Music provided to the Junior Orange Bowl will only be played over loudspeakers in the Grandstand area, and must not contain objectionable language.
11. GAPS in the parade look terrible on TV!!! Please pay attention to Junior Orange Bowl volunteers who may be directing your unit to speed up in the event there is a gap.
12. Entries will be accepted or rejected at the discretion of the Junior Orange Bowl Parade Committee.
13. All approved applicants will be acknowledged by e-mail and provided with complete parade instructions, including the staging area diagram, a route map for arrival and a route map for large buses.
14. Motorized units may not drive around the staging area after arriving and being placed in the line-up.
15. No brochures, flyers or pamphlets other than information prepared by the Junior Orange Bowl Committee may be distributed to Parade crowds.
16. **No units may have a "Santa Claus" as a person in their unit. The Junior Orange Bowl's Santa is the last unit in the parade.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Arrival Time

Staging is located on Alhambra Circle, between Douglas Road and Le Jeune Road. **All units are expected to arrive and check in with a staging representative between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Groups that arrive late may be removed from the parade lineup and denied entry to parade.** Younger children planning to participate may be brought to staging at a later time. If you have ever participated in this parade before, you know that the staging area gets really crazy with floats, horses and cars moving all around. The earlier you can come, the less stress you (and we!) will have.

Unit Themes and Costumes

We ENCOURAGE all participants in the parade to do any of the following:

- Be in costume or in coordinating clothing
- Decorate your float or motor units
- Dress up your animals
- Utilize your organization or company's mascot
- Have fun! Be creative! Get extra television time!

Girl and Boy Scout Troops

Girl Scout and Boy Scout Troops are reminded to submit the Trip and Travel Form to their Council. Other groups will also have to get permission from their organizations or notify them of their participation in the parade in order to be covered by their insurance.

Parade Route

The parade route heads south on Ponce de Leon to Miracle Mile, where it turns west and heads toward Coral Gables City Hall. Total marching time is approximately 30 - 40 minutes.

Float/Unit Judging

The float and unit judging will begin at 3:00 PM in the staging area. In years past, units have won monetary prizes and special acknowledgments in the Official Parade Program for the best use of creativity and participation.

Band Participation

Bands, please be playing your actual music (not just cadences) as you march closer towards City Hall and throughout the entire grandstand area.

Remember, you are being televised!
