



## 2023 JUNIOR ORANGE BOWL INTERNATIONAL TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP RULES & REGULATIONS

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Two matches per day may be scheduled. Night play and a third match in one day may become necessary due to inclement weather. Play will be 2 out of 3 sets in the singles draw. The qualifying draw will be the best of 2 tie-break sets and a 10-point match tie-break in lieu of a third set. Doubles will be the best of two no-ad tie-break sets with a 10-point match tiebreak in lieu of a third set. A tiebreaker to 7 points will be used in all sets. Scoring and sites may be changed due to

inclement weather. • The U.S.T.A. Point Penalty System will be enforced. Five-minute warm-up, including practice serves will be allowed. A ten-minute break is allowed between the second and third set and a new can of balls will be used for the third set. The default time is 15 minutes.

What's New Doubles will be held this year at our tournament. (Single Elimination for singles and doubles) 64 teams (128 players) will be able to compete in doubles. Teams may register at the mandatory main draw check-in on December 13th. The deadline will be 12:00 o'clock (noon) December 14th at your respective sites with play beginning on December 15th if the weather allows. "Acceptance priority for doubles will be in the following order: Two players, both Singles Main Draw participants. Two players, one a Singles Main Draw participant, the other player a Singles Qualifying participant. Two players, where both players in the team were/are Singles Qualifying participants."







