



EVENT INFORMATION

The 56th Annual Junior Orange Bowl International Golf Championship
January 2 – 6, 2020.

A) Registration is January 2nd from 1:00 – 5:00pm at the Country Club Conference Center Building at The Biltmore Hotel – located just off the first tee. This will be the Tournament Information Room for the week. Scoring will also take place in this room.

B) Practice round on January 2 (tee times are set for after 11:00 am).

Therefore, we ask that if you are able to, play your practice round prior to the 2nd. The practice round will be \$45 + 7% Florida State Sales Tax per player. Please contact the golf shop directly (305-460-5364 option #1) to schedule your time and identify yourself as a participant for the practice round on January 2nd. **PLEASE NOTE**: THERE WILL BE NO WALKING SPECTATORS ALLOWED FOR THE PRACTICE ROUND(S).

Practice balls will be provided the morning prior to each Championship round. Practice balls are not included for the practice round(s) or after play during the Championship.

C) The Players Reception/Dinner will be on January 2nd at 6:30pm in one of the Ballrooms on the lobby level of The Biltmore Hotel.

D) Daily starting times from #1 & #10 Tees will be from 7:15 – 9:15am. You are responsible for obtaining your starting time. Starting times will be posted on the tournament web page www.jrorangebowl.org/golf, outside the official office, The Biltmore Golf Shop, and The Biltmore Hotel lobby. DO NOT CALL FOR TIMES.

E) The Biltmore has a limited number of Pull Carts/Trollies for rent. These will be on a first come basis and cannot be reserved for the week. Golf carts are not permitted for spectators.

F) The Biltmore Golf Course recently completed substantial revisions to restore to the original Donald Ross design characteristics. We are confident you will enjoy the course with these upgrades. The renovations have been completed, but there may be a few isolated areas marked as ground under repair. This will be covered by the rules committee at the rules meeting for any clarification.
